Subject Options

Universities require applicants to have a minimum of 5 subjects at C grade or above. The 5 subjects must include Mathematics and English.

At this centre, students do 6 - 8 subjects.

The subjects we offer are: Mathematics, English, Accounting, Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Additional Mathematics, Business Studies, Malay & Mandarin.

Students will be assessed in 2 areas of literacy: Mathematics and English. We will then assist in the subject selection using the assessment feedback to guide us.

Students who carry fewer than 8 subjects will have the opportunity to work on assignments or do revision within the timetable.

All students will be given, and are expected to do a significant amount of independent work or assignments outside the timetable as well.

Reporting

Reports on student progress will be issued and emailed to parents.

Personal & Interpersonal Development

All students will be encouraged to work on a personal portfolio to document their extra-curricular experiences. This encourages reflection, develops a more in-depth understanding of oneself and creates an awareness of the importance of rich experiences.

These experiences can include individual pursuits such as learning to play a musical instrument, or one that develops altruistic values such as volunteering at a charitable organisation.

Tuition Fee

The fee will be collected at the beginning of each month.

Students are not allowed to attend class unless the fee has been paid within the first 10 days of each month.

The tuition fee does not include the cost of course materials (worksheets, textbooks and printed past exam papers), trips and examination fees for IGCSE examinations.
